Heat Treatment Preparation

Your home is scheduled for a bed bug heat treatment on: _______. Vacating time will be 8 to 10 hours. We will introduce hot air to your home and raise the temperature to approximately 140 degrees Fahrenheit (60 degrees Celsius). In order to ensure a successful treatment, please perform the following preparation steps:

PRIOR TO TREATMENT: Please remove the following items from the treatment area prior to the commencement of the work. The following items and others may be damaged by heat.

- O Soft vinyl items
- O Persons, plants, animals (including fish)
- O Candles, wax, crayons
- O Lipstick and other melt-able cosmetics
- O Medicines and vitamins
- O Plastic or vinyl blinds
- O Arts and crafts assembled with vinyl, wax or glues
- O Photographs (may stick together)
- O Aerosol cans, fire extinguishers and other combustible items
- O Musical instruments
- O Cigarette lighters

- O Fresh fruit, vegetables, carbonated beverages and alcohol
- Valuable oil paintings, acrylics (art work)
- O Antique furniture with fragile finish or glue points
- Computer towers and laptops
- O Any other items that may be damaged by heat

If you are unsure whether or not an item may be damaged by heat, please consult one of our technicians.

- I. Make sure that all floors are clear and that all items are elevated off the floor
- 2. Place sensitive items such as medications in the fridge
- 3. Please unplug any other electronics such as TVs, radios, clocks, etc.
- 4. Reduce and eliminate clutter as much as possible before we arrive
- 5. Please remove electrical switch plates and plug covers behind beds and sofas
- 6. Hanging clothes may remain in place, dresser drawers should have less than 4 inches of clothing

Take nothing with you on treatment day other than the clothes on your back. If any items are removed and they have bed bugs in them, the problem will start again. Make sure that clothing that you wear out of the house has been put through the dryer.

Our technicians may stand mattresses and box springs on end, move furniture away from the walls, remove items from closets, tip over sofas and couches, remove cushions, remove bedding etc. This may result in dirt and dust being disturbed. We will return items as close as possible to their original location. We will not vacuum and clean after the treatment.

Occasional bubbling, lifting and separating of laminate furniture may occur and may need to be reapplied after the heating process. Just Bugs GTA is not responsible for any damage to residence or belongings.

In the event that I/we do not comply with the requirements of this notice, I/we agree to hold Just Bugs GTA and any others involved in this service, free and harmless of any liabilities associated with the service.
