



IMPORTANT NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

Our products have no noxious odours and they leave no residual films on any surfaces.

TO ENSURE SUCCESS, THE FOLLOWING PREPARATIONS MUST BE DONE

PRIOR TO OUR ARRIVAL

- **Remove enough items from all kitchen and bathroom cupboards to allow us to access the back of every cabinet and drawer.**
- **Replace all old or ripped shelf paper.**
- **Reduce clutter! Roaches feed on a huge variety of items and hide in cluttered areas, especially those near sources of heat and in moisture.**
- **Clean, clean clean! All kitchen and bathroom surfaces must be clean and grease free, especially those areas around the fridge, stove, microwave and toaster.**

- **Throw out garbage daily and ensure dirty dishes are not left out overnight.**
- **Fix dripping taps or leaking pipes.**

After our treatment is complete all contents may be put back in place.

PLEASE DO NOT use insecticide sprays or harsh cleaners, as these will render our treatment ineffective.

You may experience activity for up to two weeks after the treatment. If activity continues in the third week, you may need a follow-up treatment.

We will be applying Maxforce Gel baits (hydramethylnon 2.15%, PCP #24240), and Avert Dry Flowable (abamectin B1 0.5%, PCP# 28403) for roach control.

For mice we will be applying ContracBlox (bromadiolone 0.005%, PCP #22239) &/or Contrac Packs (bromadiolone 0.005%, PCP #22237).

Do not touch or ingest the baits.
